Obituary

David Joseph Bouffard, 59

Dave passed away on December 15, 2010 after a year-long battle with cancer, leaving his wife Mayte Lopez Bouffard of Geneva, Switzerland. He also leaves his parents Katherine Salatiello Bouffard and Leo Joseph Bouffard of Front Royal, Virginia, two brothers of Edward L. Bouffard of St. Cloud MN and Michael B. Bouffard of Edison, NJ as well as two sisters, Jane A. Bouffard-Stettner of Westford, MA, Bettyjean Bouffard of Easthampton, MA.

Dave was a beloved uncle to several nephews and nieces and a godfather to seven children. Dave's generous, vibrant and optimistic spirit touched many people. In addition to family, Dave leaves close-knit communities of dear friends and colleagues in Geneva as well as on the US east and west coasts.

Born on March 19, 1951, Dave lived in Connecticut and Massachusetts as a child. Dave earned a bachelors degree from Holy Cross College in 1973. While at Holy Cross, David was a member of the Holy Cross Rugby team and was named New England College All-Star in 1972. Later in life, he was an avid tennis player, and remained active in many other sports. His interests also included music and writing.

During his career, Dave was a public relations executive and a journalist. For the last eight years, he was European Director of Communications for Alcoa. Previously he was European Public Relations Manager for Hewlett Packard Company. Earlier, Dave had been in Public Relations for ten years with Digital Equipment Corporation working first in their Maynard MA and later their Palo Alto, California offices. He began his career as a journalist working for a New England area newspapers as well as Computerworld.

Dave lived and worked in Geneva for the last 14 years and in California for the previous eight years. A funeral with family and European-based friends and colleagues was held in Geneva on December 21st and he was buried there.
