■ **Alert: UMass Memorial Hospital & United Healthcare Insurance**

We received urgent information from one of our members who has HP's United Healthcare Medicare Advantage Plan with PCP at UMass Memorial Hospital. What was recently learned was that this Hospital no longer accepts United Healthcare insurance. This was discovered under a normal routine visit but would have been very difficult if it were an emergency. For those who have similar coverage with your care at UMass Memorial Hospital, you might want to check with

United Healthcare to see if you need to make a change. Note, it was later discovered that there was a letter from UMass Memorial Hospital that discussed coverage from 30+ insurance companies, including, buried in the detail, the fact that UHC policies would no longer be accepted. 
