DEC Connection Zoom: The UK's Reading Digital Revolution - Wed., December 13

Did you know that our UK Reading office housed, among other functions, the corporation's development/maintenance team of 1000 ALL-IN-

1 engineers? That's an interesting fact you can ask about during our DEC Connection Zoom with our UK DEXODUS team and their talented partners!

Dear DEC Connection and DEXODUS friends, and all ex-DECcies,

Please save Wednesday, December 13 at 11 am EST, 4 pm GMT, and 8 am PST for an exciting DEC Connection Corporate Zoom event.

We are excited to invite you to hear the first presentation of the history and plans for the UK's *Reading Digital Revolution* project. This will culminate in 2025 in a display at the Reading Museum celebrating the 60th anniversary of Digital's

opening its Reading UK office. Digital's foothold began the build-up of a technology center that over the years built a thriving economy in Reading and led to creation of a center of technology and computer education.

The entire effort is an effective and motivated partnership between once-private industry (Digital UK's DEXODUS and UK DECUS), government (UK Reading Museum, the National Museum of Computing, and the UK National Lottery Fund) and private education (University of Reading Computer Science Department).

This first presentation will feature 6 speakers: an introduction from Sandy Mackenzie from the DEXODUS team; Brendan Carr, Reading *Digital Revolution* project director from the host Reading Museum; Jacqui Garrad, Director of the UK's National Museum of Computing, and her consultant Gavin Clarke; Ian Severn, Chairman of UK DECUS; and John Barrett, Chairman of DEXODUS. Each speaker will describe their personal role in the original organizations and with this project, describe what their group is doing, and comment on the impact that Digital and the technology center had on the success of their organization, and the greater impact on Reading and its economy over the years.
